



Co-op is also an opportunity to develop professional contacts within the industry and enhance your résumé while studying. Students are usually placed in entry-level positions and their placement will depend on the student's program of choice, English level and previous academic and professional experience.





## **Working Off-Campus**







# **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

In order to be admitted to ILAC International College, students need to fulfill requirements regarding their educational qualification and English level.

#### All applicants must:

- Have a High School/Secondary School Diploma or higher education\*
- Have a successful interview with an ILAC International College team member

All applicants whose first language is not English must provide proof of English proficiency. Please refer to the chart below for the language entry level required for your program.

## VISA

## **Study Permit**

As an international student studying for longer than six months, you will need a permit to study in Canada. An entry visa will also be required for most countries. Before you submit a study permit application, you will need:

- A letter of acceptance from ILAC International College with our DLI number (Vancouver 0110957942277 / Toronto 019319417742)
- Financial proof that you can support yourself while studying at ILAC International College (tuition fees and living expenses)
- A medical exam, if required
- Biometrics, if required

### **Off-Campus Work**

International students enrolled in full-time programs of 26 weeks or longer are eligible to work off-campus for up to 20 hours per week as part of their studies.

#### Co-op Work Permit

If your study includes a co-op or work placement, all international students are required to apply for a co-op work permit as well as a study permit. You must submit the application for a co-op work permit alongside the study permit. This document will allow you to work full time during your co-op work placement and you need to present the permit before your co-op component starts.

#### **Interview**

All students planning to attend ILAC International College are required to join an interview to determine if the chosen program is right for them. The interview will also assess the student's English level and can be conducted in person or by Skype.

#### Step 1

#### Step 2

After receiving the required documentation, we will send you:

- A link to our FREE online English assessment test (not applicable if you provide Official English test results - IELTS Academic or TOEFL).
- A link to schedule a Skype or in-person interview to make a final assessment of your English level and determine if the program is right for you.

## Step 3

If you are accepted to the program after the interview, we will provide a Letter of Acceptance.

#### Step 4

Apply for your Student Permit/Co-op Work Permit/VISA, if applicable.


